Comprehensive support for Singaporeans to start and raise families

1 Housing



- Significant housing subsidies and grants for First-Timers buying new and resale HDB flats
- First-Timer (Parents & Married Couples) get three ballot chances and first priority for 4R and smaller Standard flats under Family and Parenthood Priority Scheme
- About 19,600 Build-To-Order flats will be launched in 2025
- Over 5,500 Sale of Balance (SBF) flats were launched in Feb 2025, with another SBF exercise planned in 2025
- Doubling of Parenthood Provisional Housing Scheme (PPHS) flat supply to 4,000 units by 2H 2025
- Meanwhile, one-year PPHS (Open Market) Voucher from Jul 2024 to support eligible families renting a HDB flat from the open market, while awaiting completion of their HDB flats

2 Maternity & Healthcare



- Increased MediSave Grant for Newborns by \$1,000 to \$5,000 from 1 Apr 2025
- Fully-subsidised childhood vaccinations and developmental check-ups[#]
- MediSave Maternity Package
- MediSave and co-funding for Assisted Conception Procedures and Pre-Implantation Genetic Testing
- **[New]** Grow Well SG strategy launched to enhance preventive care and inculcate healthier lifestyles in children

[#] Vaccinations refer to those under the National Childhood Immunisation Schedule.

3 Caregiving Support, Preschool & Education



- Over \$200,000 in subsidies by the time the child finishes secondary school
- **[Enhanced]** Reductions in full-day childcare fee caps in Anchor and Partner Operator preschools, to \$640 and \$680 respectively in 2025 and \$610 and \$650 respectively in 2026
- Around 40,000 new infant care and childcare places from 2025 to 2029
- Three-year childminding pilot for infants

4 Financial Support



- From the Baby Bonus Scheme, MediSave Grant for Newborns* and Large Families Scheme:
 - 1st child: Up to \$25,000
 - 2nd child: Up to \$28,000
 - 3rd and 4th child: Up to \$48,000
 - 5th and subsequent child: Up to \$54,000
- Parenthood tax reliefs and rebate
- **[New]** Large Families Scheme with up to \$16,000 of additional support for the third and subsequent child
 - ▶ **[Enhanced]** Increased Child Development Account First Step Grant of \$10,000
 - ▶ **[New]** \$5,000 Large Family MediSave Grant
 - ▶ **[New]** \$1,000 annually in Large Family LifeSG Credits for each eligible child aged 1 to 6

* Enhanced to \$5,000 for babies born from 1 Apr 2025. Figures reflect post-enhancement amounts.

5 Managing Work & Family Life



- **[Enhanced]** 30 weeks of paid parental leave by 1 Apr 2026, which comprise 16 weeks of Government-Paid Maternity Leave, 4 weeks[†] of Government-Paid Paternity Leave and 10 weeks of new Shared Parental Leave^{††}
- Childcare Leave and Unpaid Infant Care Leave
- New Tripartite Guidelines on Flexible Work Arrangement (FWA) Requests set out the process for employees to formally request FWAs, and for employers to consider and respond to such requests on reasonable business grounds

[†] 2 weeks currently provided on voluntary basis will be mandated from 1 Apr 2025
^{††} The new Shared Parental Leave will be implemented in two phases, starting with 6 weeks from 1 Apr 2025, and increasing to 10 weeks from 1 Apr 2026
