Comprehensive support for Singaporeans to start and raise families

- **[NEW]** Inter-agency Workgroup to engage widely across members of the public, businesses and the people sector and holistically look into marriage and parenthood issues
- Marriage and Parenthood Survey to be conducted this year to gain deeper insights on how attitudes and perceptions towards marriage and parenthood have evolved

1 Housing



- Significant housing subsidies and grants for First-Timers buying new and resale HDB flats
- First-Timer (Parents & Married Couples) get three ballot chances and first priority for 4R and smaller Standard flats under Family and Parenthood Priority Scheme
- Staggered Downpayment Scheme and Deferred Income Assessment to keep flats affordable for young couples whose incomes may still be stabilising
- About 19,600 Build-To-Order flats will be launched in 2026, of which more than 4,000 flats will be Shorter Waiting Time (SWT) flats with wait times of less than three years
- Over 4,000 Sale of Balance (SBF) flats were launched in Feb 2026, with almost one in 5 already completed for those looking to move in sooner
- Doubled Parenthood Provisional Housing Scheme (PPHS) flat supply to 4,000 units in 2025
- **[Enhanced]** Double the Third Child Priority Scheme quota to up to 10% (from up to 5%) from 2026. Eligibility criteria expanded to include families where the mother is expecting a third child

2 Maternity & Healthcare



- MediSave and co-funding for Assisted Conception Procedures and Pre-Implantation Genetic Testing
- MediSave Maternity Package for pre-delivery medical expenses and baby delivery expenses
- Fully-subsidised childhood vaccinations and developmental check-ups[#]
- Grow Well SG strategy to enhance preventive care and inculcate healthier lifestyles in children

[#] Vaccinations refer to those under the National Childhood Immunisation Schedule

3 Caregiving Support, Preschool & Education



- Over \$200,000 in subsidies by the time the child finishes secondary school
- Three-year childminding pilot for infants
- Since end-2025, 80% of preschoolers can have a place in a government-supported preschool
- Around 40,000 new infant care and childcare places from 2025 to 2029
- Reductions in full-day childcare fee caps in Anchor and Partner Operator preschools, to \$610 and \$650 respectively in 2026
- **[Enhanced]** Monthly household income threshold for means-tested preschool subsidies increased to \$15,000 from 1 Jan 2027
- **[Enhanced]** Monthly household income threshold for Student Care Fee Assistance increased to \$6,500 from 1 Jan 2027
- **[New]** Enhanced quality of the preschool sector to support children's holistic development

4 Financial Support



- From the Baby Bonus Scheme, MediSave Grant for Newborns, and Large Families Scheme:
 - 1st child: Up to \$25,000
 - 2nd child: Up to \$28,000
 - 3rd and 4th child: Up to \$48,000
 - 5th and subsequent child: Up to \$54,000
- Parenthood tax reliefs and rebate
- Large Families Scheme to support families with three or more children
 - ▶ Increased Child Development Account First Step Grant of \$10,000 (up from \$5,000)
 - ▶ \$5,000 Large Family MediSave Grant
 - ▶ \$6,000 Large Family LifeSG Credits*
- **[New]** \$500 Child LifeSG Credits per child**

* \$1,000 annually from the year that the child turns 1 to the year that the child turns 6
 ** For each Singaporean Citizen child aged 0 to 12 (born from 1 January 2014 to 31 December 2026)

5 Managing Work & Family Life



- 30 weeks of paid parental leave from 1 Apr 2026, which comprise 16 weeks of Government-Paid Maternity Leave, 4 weeks of Government-Paid Paternity Leave and 10 weeks of new Shared Parental Leave[†]
- Childcare Leave and Unpaid Infant Care Leave
- Tripartite Guidelines on Flexible Work Arrangement (FWA) Requests set out the process for employees to formally request FWAs, and for employers to consider and respond to such requests on reasonable business grounds

[†] The new Shared Parental Leave will increase to 10 weeks from 1 Apr 2026
